

The freedom South Africans enjoy today evolved from Soweto and from the suburb of Crawford where Alexander Sinton and Belgravia High schools were located. This was in the vicinity of City Park, with Sinton right next to the fields of City Park. This 20 year period was seen through the eyes of Henry Africa, a man voted as the Best Baseball Player of 1984 at the national tournament in Port Elizabeth. The next year he was voted as the Best Baseball player in the Western Cape. The year was 1985. We were still 9 years from democratic elections, but we were not to know that yet. The riots of 1976 took place around the areas of Crawford. Tyres were burnt. Cars and buses set alight. Children died and adults were detained without trial. A baseball player was part of the police force and acted against his own community. Time would heal the wounds. But that healing would take a very long time to arrive. Truth and reconciliation would come well after 1994 to the families who were once united in the games played at City Park. From different suburbs they came, played baseball, softball, rugby and netball. All this happened in the years of apartheid. Our eyes were to be opened by the 1976 riots all across South Africa.
